

# **Battery Changing Instructions**

- Open the hook-and-loop fastener on the bottom of your Purrble companion
- 2 Use a Philips/cross-head screwdriver to loosen the screw in the battery cover (screw attached to cover)
- **3** Remove cover and discard the two batteries
- 4 Replace with two new 1.5V AA alkaline batteries
- 5 Replace cover, tighten screw, and close the hook-and-loop fastener



Your Purrble companion conserves battery life by going to sleep when not in use. Leave switched on unless you will not be playing for a week or more.

### IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

Batteries should be replaced by an adult.

#### **▲** CAUTION

#### 1. SAFE HANDLING

- a. Keep batteries and tools well out of reach of children.
- b. Batteries must only be inserted by an adult.

#### 2. TO AVOID BATTERY LEAKAGE

- a. Use only 1.5 V "AA" (LR6) alkaline batteries.
- b. Carefully insert the batteries correctly by matching the + and polarity markings.
- c. Do not mix old batteries and new batteries or standard (carbon-zinc) with alkaline batteries.
- d. Remove exhausted or dead batteries from the product.
- e. Remove batteries if the product is not to be used for a long time.
- f. Do not short-circuit the + and terminals.
- g. RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES: Do not mix these with any other types of batteries. Always remove from the product before recharging. Recharge batteries under adult supervision.

DO NOT RECHARGE OTHER TYPES OF BATTERIES.

- Should this product cause, or be affected by, local electrical interference, move it away from other equipment. Reset (switching off and back on again or removing and re-inserting batteries) if necessary.
- 4. Properly dispose of batteries check call2recycle.org for options near you.
- x2 1.5V AA ALKALINE BATTERIES INCLUDED. Replace with 2x 1.5V "AA" size alkaline batteries. Phillips/cross-head screwdriver (not included) needed to replace batteries.

#### A DANGER TO PREVENT ELECTRIC SHOCK

Do not immerse in water! Surface wash only.

Spot clean using a slightly damp cloth or disinfectant wipe.

## Create a nighttime routine

We've heard that the Purrble companion helps people wind down for sleep. Try taking deep breaths while soothing your Purrble companion. You can even add aromatherapy or soft lights to this routine.



# Keep your companion nearby

Many people reach for their Purrble companion specifically to help during moments of stress, worry, and other big emotions. Keep your Purrble companion in a designated place, so you can reach for them easily during these moments.



## Tune into the details

Hold your Purrble companion to your chest or ear, and focus your attention on their soft heartbeat, quiet language, and the feeling of their ears, feet, and belly. Quiet by nature, your Purrble companion will even softly snore when falling asleep after inactivity!



## Build a bond

Finding calm with your Purrble companion works best when you share a special bond with your friend. Name your Purrble companion and decorate their cozy box. Go wild!


